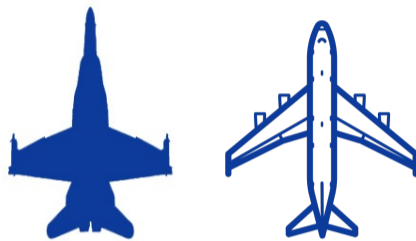
The number of employees Boeing has worldwide. 90% are here in the U.S. and 7,500+ are in South Carolina.
